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The correct author citation of the recently published name Pluteus fenzlii

The combination *Pluteus fenzlii* (Schulzer) Corriol et P.-A. Moreau was published 23 days before the combination *Pluteus fenzlii* (Schulzer) E. Malyszheva, Morozova et Zvyagina and, therefore, has priority.

Kombinace *Pluteus fenzlii* (Schulzer) Corriol et P.-A. Moreau byla publikována o 23 dní dříve než kombinace *Pluteus fenzlii* (Schulzer) E. Malyszheva, Morozova et Zvyagina, a má tedy prioritu.

RESULTS AND DISCUSSION

For tens of years, *Agaricus fenzlii* Schulzer has been placed in the genus *Chamaeota* (W. G. Sm.) Earle (e. g. Singer 1986). However, recent studies (Corriol and Moreau 2007, Malyszheva et al. 2007) have revealed that the species should be placed in *Pluteus* Fr. In both studies, the new combination *Pluteus fenzlii* was designated. A question has appeared which combination has priority and which should be considered an "isonym" without nomenclatural status.

In Persoonia 19(2): 248, the combination *Pluteus fenzlii* (Schulzer) Corriol et P.-A. Moreau was published. According to Connie Baak, the desk editor of Persoonia (April 2008, pers. comm.), the printed version of this journal number was available on the 8th of August 2007; the same date has been indicated also in the electronic version of Persoonia [http://www.ingentaconnect.com/content/nhn/pimj/2007/00000019/00000002/art00003 (accessed 21th April 2008)]. The librarian Alena Kubátová has confirmed (April 2008, pers. comm.) that Persoonia 19(2) was received in August 2007 by the library of the Czech Scientific Society for Mycology in Prague which is the confirmation of the dates given by the editors of Persoonia.

In Acta Mycologica 42(2): 155, the combination *Pluteus fenzlii* (Schulzer) E. Malyszheva, Morozova et Zvyagina was published. According to Maria Lawrynowicz, the editor of Acta Mycologica (March 2008, pers. comm.), this journal number went out from the print on 31th of August 2007 and was available during the 54th Conference of Polish Botanical Society (3–8th September 2007) in Szczecin.

According to the International Code of Botanical Nomenclature (McNeill et al. 2006; Art. 6.3, Note 2), "when the same name, based on the same type, has been published independently at different times by different authors, then only the earliest of these "isonyms" has nomenclatural status". Consequently, the correct name of *Agaricus fenzlii* Schulzer within the genus *Pluteus* is as follows:
